

**MAYOR-PRESIDENT PROCLAMATION:
EMERGENCY ORDER DECLARING CURFEW FOR LAFAYETTE
PARISH, LOUISIANA**

WHEREAS, Lafayette Parish is faced with the threat of widespread wind and water damage, injury and/or loss of life or property resulting from severe weather, in the form of heavy rains, high winds, and flooding caused by the effects of Tropical Storm Laura and Tropical Storm Marco in Lafayette Parish; and

WHEREAS, immediate emergency actions are required to minimize the imminent effects of this severe weather event; and

WHEREAS, the Lafayette Mayor-President, as authorized by Louisiana law, including but not limited to the Louisiana Homeland Security and Emergency Assistance and Disaster Act (La. R.S. 29: 721, et seq.) as well as any applicable provision of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government Home Rule Charter is authorized to declare a state of local disaster and/or emergency for Lafayette Parish under these circumstances; and

WHEREAS, the Lafayette Mayor-President has declared that a state of local disaster and/or emergency for Lafayette Parish, Louisiana exists under the aforesaid authority in a declaration signed and effective August 23, 2020 at 12:00 PM.

NOW, THEREFORE, Josh Guillory, Lafayette Mayor-President, hereby declares the following, effective at 8:00 PM on August 26, 2020 and continuing until 6:00 AM on August 27, 2020:

1. A curfew is imposed for all public places within Lafayette Parish during the hours of 8:00 PM to 6:00 AM.

2. During the hours of curfew, all persons are prohibited from occupying, using, standing, sitting, traveling, or being present in any public place, including for the purposes of travel, with the following exceptions:

- a. All law enforcement, fire, paramedics, or other medical personnel, essential services restoration and repair personnel, as well as any other first responders or emergency response personnel authorized by Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government.
- b. Credentialed news media.
- c. Individuals traveling to seek exempt care.

3. For purposes of this emergency order, "travel" includes, without limitation, travel on foot, motorcycle, automobile, or any other mode of transporting a person from one location to another.

4. For purposes of this emergency order, "public place" means any outdoor place, whether privately or publicly owned property, generally accessible to the general public,

including but not limited to public streets and roads, highways, driveways, sidewalks, parks, and vacant lots. For purposes of this emergency, "public place" does not include the Lafayette Regional Airport.

5. For purposes of this emergency order, "exempt care" means necessary medical services and supplies for an individual's self or family member.

6. Violators of this emergency proclamation/order shall be punished in accordance with the laws of Louisiana and/or the City-Parish of Lafayette.
